

Are You Spending a Lot on Prescriptions?

The Part D Low Income Subsidy (LIS) “Extra Help” Program Can Help You

To qualify you must meet the income and resource limits shown below.

2019 Partial LIS Extra Help

Income Limit*	Asset Limit**	Your Out of Pocket Cost
\$1,581/month (individual)	\$14,390 (individual)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ \$0 to \$83 annual deductible ▪ You pay 15% of drug costs ▪ When your total out of pocket costs reach \$5,100, you pay \$3.40 to \$8.50 or 5% of the drug cost
\$2,134/month (married couple)	\$28,720 (married couple)	

* In-kind support is not counted towards the income limit.

** Asset limits include \$1,500 per person for burial expenses. The home you live in, your cars, and life insurance policies are not counted as assets.

If you have Medicare and full Medi-Cal, you are already enrolled in this program. You should be paying \$1.25 for generics and \$3.80 for brand name drugs.
