\$1,595/month (individual)	\$14,610 (individual)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ You pay 15% of drug costs ▪ When your total out of pocket costs reach \$6,350, you pay \$3.60 to \$8.95 or 5% of the drug cost
\$2,155/month (married couple)	\$29,160 (married couple)	

*Asset limits include \$1,500 per person for burial expenses. The home you live in, your cars, and life insurance policies are not counted as assets.
